

IMPORTANT NOTES

Scope of Work.

1. The scope of this proposal includes the design, fabrication, and installation of a complete steel structure pedestrian bridge. The bridge will span 40 feet in length and 6 feet in width, positioned at a height of 19 feet above ground level. The work includes the provision and execution of all necessary components, including:

Footings and foundation work

Steel structural members

Connections and welding

Surface Preparation and Painting

2. All work will be carried out in strict accordance with the attached design drawings and technical specifications.

3. The contractor shall complete the scope of work within the agreed-upon timeline, as specified in the contract. Timely completion is a material condition of this agreement. In the event of delay not justified by approved extensions, liquidated damages of up to 10% of the total contract value may be imposed for failure to meet the completion deadline. These damages shall be considered as compensation for the delay and not as a penalty.

4. All materials used for the execution of the work shall be ISI-certified and shall conform to relevant Indian Standards. Materials shall be sourced from approved brands only, with TATA being the preferred and recommended manufacturer, subject to the engineer's/consultant's approval.

5. The contractor shall be fully responsible for ensuring the safety of all personnel, equipment, and third parties at the worksite for the entire duration of the project. The contractor must implement and maintain appropriate safety measures in compliance with applicable laws and industry standards. All necessary personal protective equipment (PPE) and safety gear shall be provided and used at all times. Any accidents, injuries, or damages occurring during the execution of the work shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor.

6. The execution of the work shall strictly adhere to the approved structural design and drawings. However, any modifications required due to site conditions may be considered.

7. Bidders are required to submit their rate quotations in the provided specification table. The contract for execution of the work will be awarded to the contractor offering the lowest responsive and technically compliant bid.

8. The final payment shall be made only after the completion of a detailed audit and verification of the work executed at the site. The amount payable will be based on the actual work completed, as measured and certified by the authorized engineer or consultant, in accordance with the approved drawings and specifications.

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
